### Application

<b>Process Conditions :</b>	Not less than + 5 °C or more than 35 °C support and environment temperature. Avoid direct sunlight or strong wind.
<b>Suitable Substrates :</b>	Mineral substrates (roughcast mortar group P II, P III, concrete, brickwork, fibred cement), wood, metals (iron, steel, aluminium, galvanised surfaces), hard PVC, GfK (glass fibre reinforced plastics), old layers of paint.

<b>Substrate Preparation :</b>	The substrate has to be clean, dry, solid and free from dust, oil, grease, wax and corrosion products. <b>Mineral substrates:</b> remove dust and loose particles <b>Ferrous metal, steel:</b> clean, eventually sand (remove rust and corrosion products) degrease with Mipa Silikonentferner (anti-silicone). <b>Zinc:</b> clean with ammonia alkaline wetting agent (Mipa Zinkreiniger). <b>Aluminium:</b> clean, sand and degrease with Mipa Silikonentferner. <b>Hard PVC, GfK:</b> clean, sand and degrease with Mipa Kunststoffreiniger (plastics cleaner). <b>Wood:</b> clean, sand and blow off all dust.

<b>Drying times :</b>	At 20 °C and 65 % relative air humidity: recoatable after 60 - 90 minutes. Prolonged drying time after treatment at lower temperature.
<b>Consumption :</b>	Approx. 7 m <sup>2</sup> /litre each operation, according to the substrate (for more precise details, please check on the substrate).

### Special Recommendations

Brilliant, intensive colours, owing to circumstances, may exhibit a reduced opacity. Practical experience demonstrates that in this case it is advisable to apply a first coat in a pastel colour of related shade based on white. Eventually a second coat would be necessary. Do not inhale aerosols. Stir well and strain before Airless application.

### Safety Instructions

Mipa House-Paint is slightly alkaline. Protect eyes and sensitive skin against splashes. Wash away colour traces immediately with sufficient clear water. Consider general hygienic rules.
